FROM FATHER BERNIE: Please allow me to take a few minutes of your time for an "update" from me. Thursday, January 25, will mark two weeks for being at St. Mary Home, East. I have been receiving physical therapy twice each day, except Saturday and Sunday. The therapy staff is satisfied with my progress. However, they feel I would benefit more by staying one more week, especially since my bedroom and bathroom at St. Stan's is on the second floor and, more importantly, since no one, other than myself, lives at the rectory. **HOWEVER**, my insurance coverage feels that I have made sufficient progress and that their coverage would end by Thursday, January 25! I was advised that I have the right to appeal that decision. I have done that and now I await the results of that decision. I am assured that there are other roads to take to assure my full rehab process....I sincerely appreciate your continuing prayers, greetings, encouraging words of support as well as the help you have extended to Msgr. Bob Smith and Father Bill Sutherland in my absence. I had an appointment with Dr. Mark Buscek, my surgeon, this past Tuesday. He was very pleased with my progress. He agreed that I would benefit greatly from another week at St. Mary Home. He had the staples removed from my knee and that has brought more relief to the surgical area. I also want to extend thanks to Deacon Bob for watching over the needs of St. Stans Parish and Msgr. Dan Magraw for watching over the needs of Holy Trinity Parish. We continue our journey of Faith trusting in God's presence in our lives and doing our best to build God's Kingdom. With many prayers, Father Bernie
